- **Review Process:** All contributions submitted for publication will be subjected to peer-review. The Chief Editor reserves the right of making editorial modifications in the manuscript to meet the standards.
- **Paper Format:** 3000-8000 words, and book reviews should be neatly typed as Word document with 1.5 spacing in Times New Roman, 12-point font size justified text. The author(s) must also submit the soft copy of the paper through e-mail.
- The paper should be accompanied with an Abstract (150-300 words) and a list of keywords.
- Footnotes to the text should be avoided. If required, they should be numbered consecutively and presented as endnotes.
- References should be specified in the text by giving the name of author(s), with the year of publication in parentheses. All references should be alphabetically listed at the end of the paper in the standard APA format.
- The authors should submit the copyright form in the given format.
