- Divergent roles of Scrum in Agile.

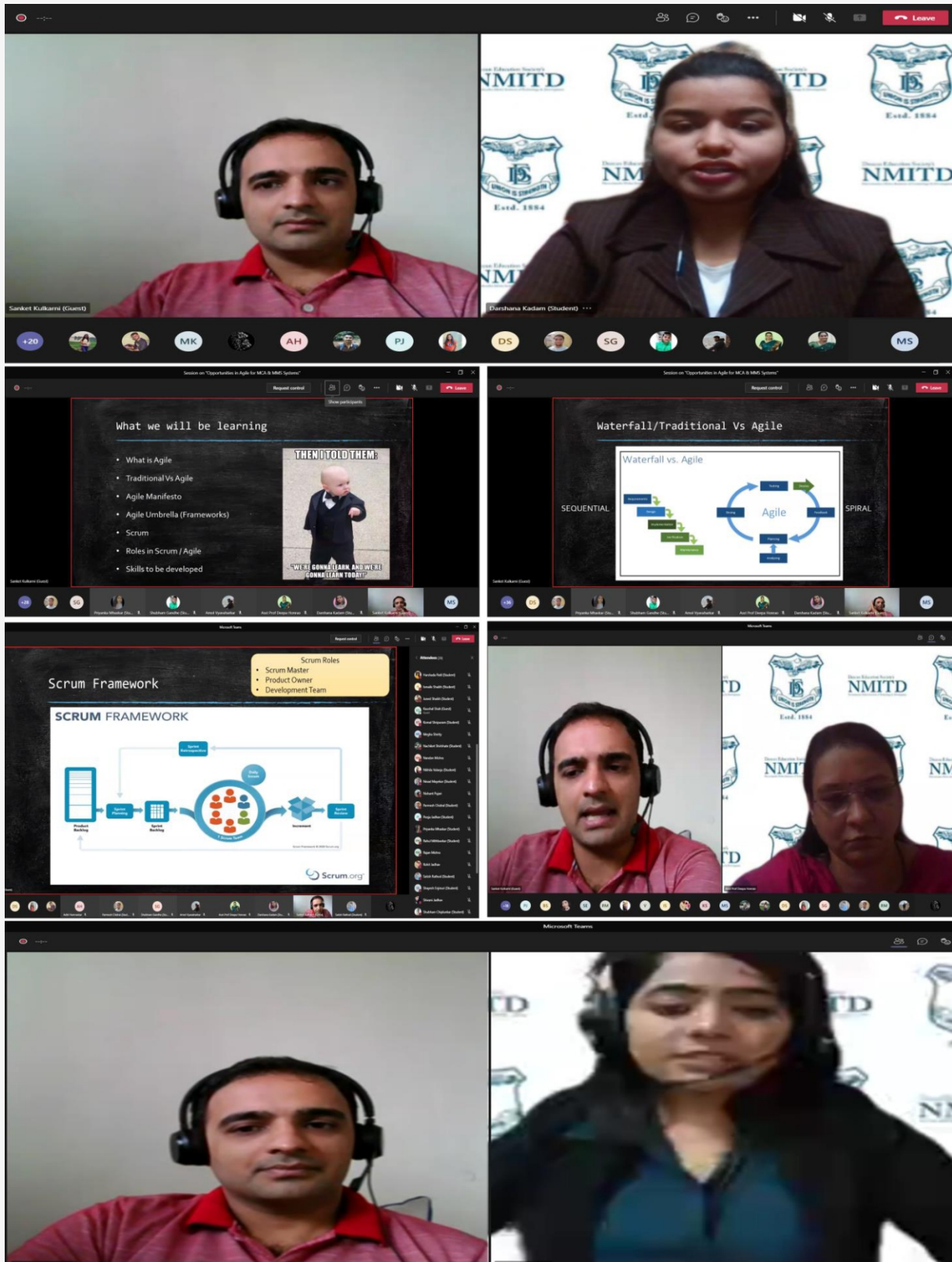

Jack of all at Entry Level- Mostly works in Campus Interview.

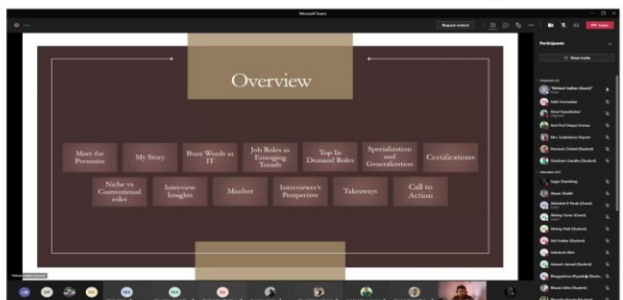

Publishing the dashboards across multiple platforms.

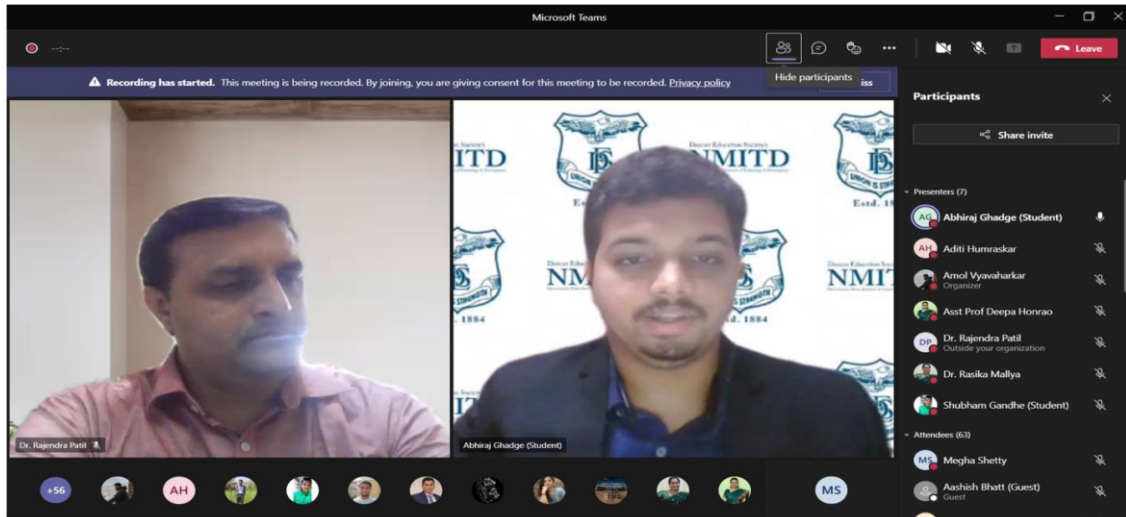

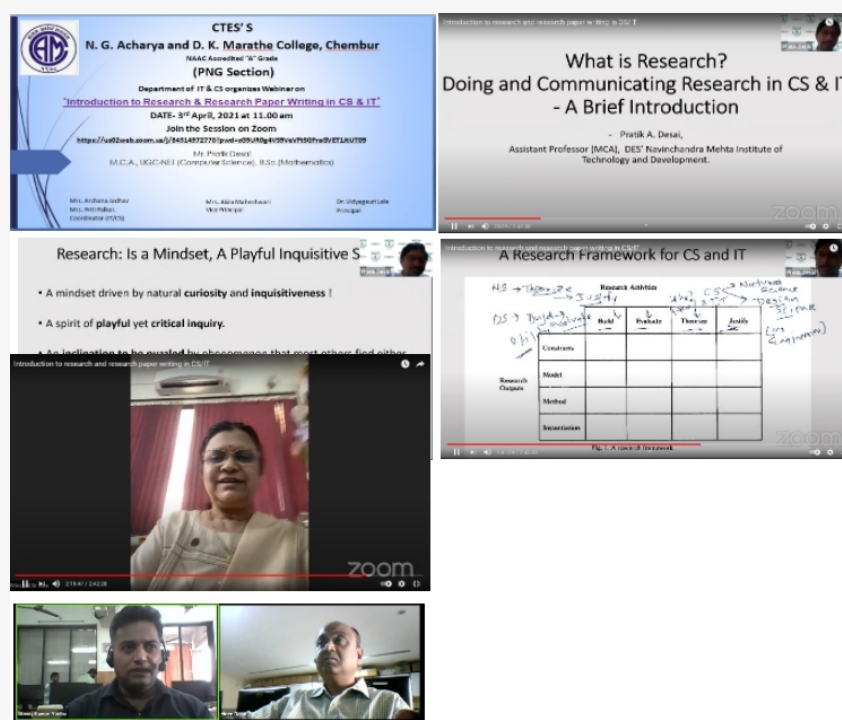



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Report on the “One Day Virtual National Conference Ono Conference on Leveraging Technologies and Management Skills To Improve Economy During New Normal” jointly organized by DES’s NMITD and PTVAIM

Date: 6th March 2021

Background:

All countries across the globe are striving hard to pull economies out of Covid 19 induced recession. there is a need for extensive research for understanding the impact of the crisis on people and businesses and to find effective solutions to these problems.

The key areas under exploration here are human behavior management skills and technologies. Covid 19 has questioned every successful management strategy and our personal and professional life. The situational questions for research that are raised here are; will the same management principles and strategies help us to recover from the crisis? And what changes in business management may make recovery faster?

Though the world was slowly preparing itself for digital transformation, Covid 19 has forced all of us to embrace digitalization on an immediate and urgent basis and this shall accelerate several major trends that were already well underway before the pandemic. Companies will need to provide products and services that adhere to the most rigorous health and safety conditions and be able to show or explain them to clients. Pertinent questions are raised that explore answers to the following points: what do we need to do to build innovations that reduce human-to-human contact, automate processes, optimize work from home while allowing them to maintain their psychological health, increase accessibility to e-learning, and enhanced productivity amidst social distancing.

Brief introduction about the conference:

One day national confidence was gently organized on a virtual zoom platform by DES’s NMITD and PTVAIM dated 6th March 2021. The theme of the conference was leveraging



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technologies and management skills to improve the economy during the new normal. The total number of research papers received was 70. The total number of papers accepted was around 60. The papers were forwarded to be published in Scopus (Psychology and Education), Web of Science (Special issue on technical, education, and management sciences), and UGC care (Shodh Sarita) depending on the quality of the papers and choice of the authors.

The keynote speaker for management was Shri. Sunil Singh and the keynote speaker for technology was Shri. Shirish Kulkarni. Chairs for technology were Dr. Suhasini Vijaykumar Director BVIMIT and for management was Dr. Anand Hindolia Assistant Professor MMS Department PTVAIM. 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The presentations took place in 2 parallel tracks one was technology and the other was management. The keynote speakers discussed the theme of the conference and subthemes and gave insights into the implication of the theme in the corporate and academic scenario. The session chair introduced the theme at the start for both the tracks and gave a constructive review to each presenter highlighting the strengths in their research paper and the areas of improvement. 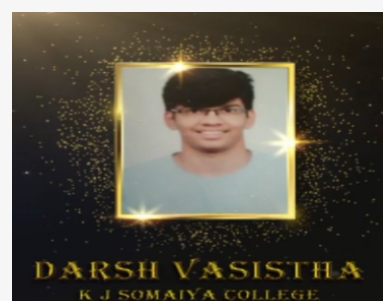

One of the novel experiential learning pedagogy which was introduced in the year 2011, at DES's NMITD is "BSE IPF Sponsored, Share Khan Ltd Co-sponsored – Share Bazaar". Unlike Mock Stock, in this event, the participants, do live trading on BOLTD. They make a team of two participants and invest INR 1000 for day through their demat cum trading account and do day trading on select shares of BOLT, on second day of the event. They get an exposure to the tune of 5 times due to the recent SEBI regulations.

This year Share Bazaar celebrated its decade's success by a virtual event with 174 participants from Mumbai, Thane, Nasik, Nagpur, Kanpur, Raipur and Lucknow from 15th to 17th March 2021. The winning teams got various cash prize totaling Rs32,000.

The Virtual Inaugural Session was done by Mr. In Conversation, Mr. Palak Shah, Authour of Market Mafia along with Veteran Stock Brokers and Academician, Mr. Rajesh Dedhia, Director, Vantage Knowledge Academy. 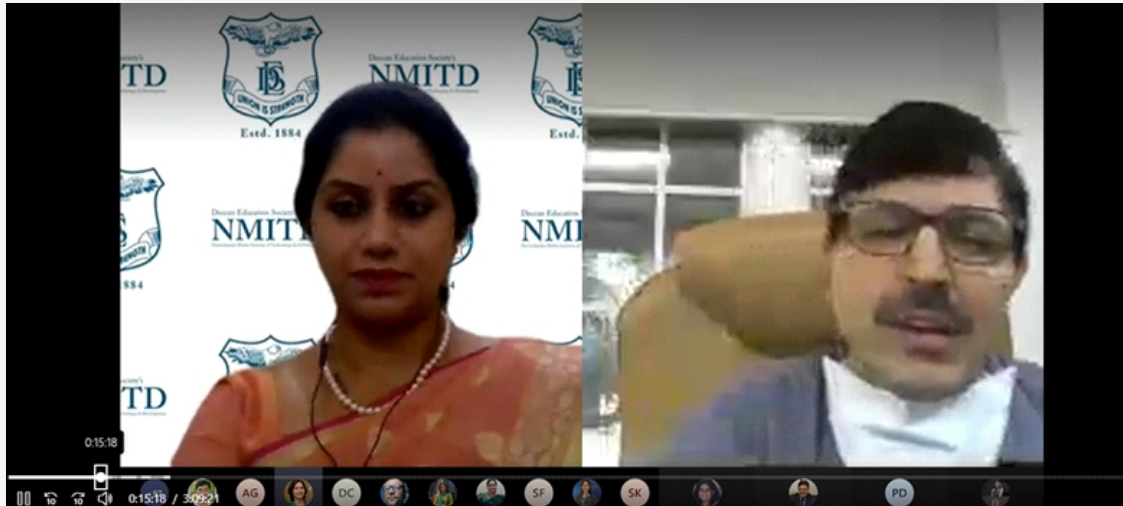

Over 39,000 Colleges and over 18000 Post Graduate Institutions of Higher Education Institution (HEI) cater to 27.5 Million undergraduate and four million post graduates in India (World Bank Report, 2019). One of the important aspects would be the quality of faculty since the primary objective of any institution is the quality of education it imparts. The faculty are majorly responsible for this along with other factors like education tools, library, research databases. The University Grants Commission has a way of assessing the academicians by way of Academic Performance Indicators (API) which gives a greater weightage to the research. 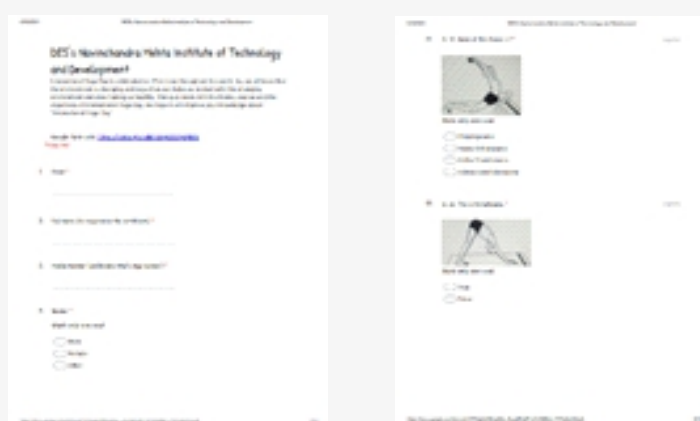


20TH JUNE 2020 : YOGA DAY QUIZ

Total 528 participants attempted this quiz. Librarian issued the appreciation certificates to the participants who scored more than 60% score.

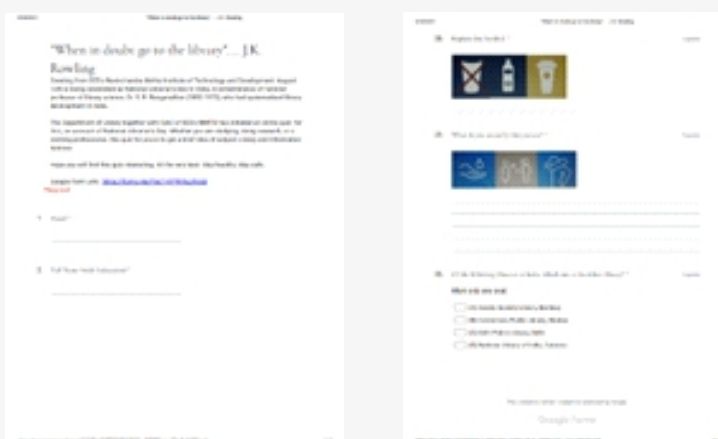

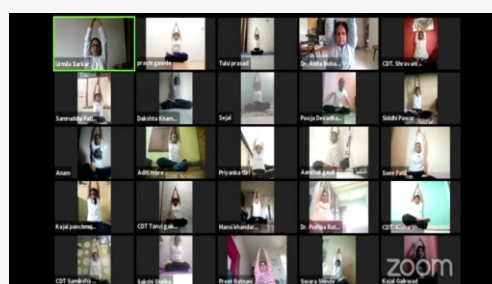
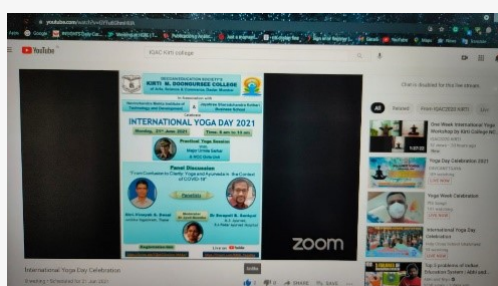
21st June, International Yoga Day, was celebrated at Deccan Education Society Mumbai Campus.
