Accreditation is a process of quality assurance and improvement, whereby a programme in an approved Institution is critically appraised to verify that the Institution or the programme continues to meet and/or exceed the Norms and Standards prescribed by regulator from time to time. It is a kind of recognition which indicates that a programme or Institution fulfills certain standards. NMITD-IQAC has initiated accreditation of MCA Programme. After submission of Self-Assessment Report, Peer Team Visit was scheduled by NBA on 23rd December to 25th December 2022. The Peer Team was comprised of Prof. Dr. J.L. Rana, Prof. R.K. Agrawal and Prof. C. Ramkrishna. The visit and inspection were executed as per the detailed schedule given by the NBA office.

Outcome: Whole Institute has worked very hard with full dedication to get this accreditation. The steering committee, all criteria convenors, non-teaching staff have executed their responsibilities completely and MCA programme got accredited by NBA for 2 years. The Institute scored 633 points in NBA accreditation.

The findings appreciated by Peer Team were OBE mechanism, academic infrastructure, success rate, enrollment ratio, and faculty retention. The findings where the Institute must work are research funds, inter-institute events, interaction with the outside world etc.

After accreditation, the department has received appreciation from DES management and all stakeholders. The department has got visibility at national level. This success of the Institute was possible due to the hard work of NMITD teaching and non-teaching staff and strong support of DES management and all stakeholders such as alumni, parents, recruiters etc.

MOCK INTERVIEWS AND INTERACTION WITH INDUSTRY EXPERTS **At DES's Navinchandra Mehta Institute of Technology and Development** **Conducted by Alumni, Training and Placement Cell** **6th and 27th of August 2022.**

Introduction: The placement journey is enthralling and stimulating during tough competition especially when a variety of career options are available for MCA graduates. Every student is skilled and competent in their own respective merits. Student preparedness for placements is crucial, where mentors play an important role. Keeping this in mind DES's NMITD organized a two-day Mock Interviews and Interaction with Industry Experts activity on the 6th and 27th of August 2022. A total

of eight alumni were invited to the campus, who hold outstanding industrial or academic experience in their respective domains and have been through a similar placement season during their academic journey at DES's NMITD.

About Mock Interviews and Interaction with Industry Experts: This activity was initiated by inviting most of the alumni who have completed more than nine years in the industry to share their experiences with students considering their own path and journey towards excellence. In addition, alumni build stronger connections with the Institute through interaction which would lead to a long-term association for placements, admissions, guest sessions, industry-ISR activities, handholding through projects and internships, etc.

Activity conduct and observations: The Mock interviews mimicked the real interviews. It started with an aptitude test followed by the evaluation of the test papers and face-to-face interviews. Each interview session was followed by rigorous feedback and counseling. Interviewers provided detailed and customized feedback to the respective student about what strong points they need to retain during the real interviews and where they can improve through reading, practice, certifications, projects, referencing, etc.

Feedback and Recommendations: The interviewers appreciated the well-conducted initiative by Alumni, Training, and Placement Cell. They mentioned providing preplacement preparatory activities to the students to improve their technical abilities and communication skills. The students benefitted from the guidance received by alumni industry experts and various open-source links to explore hands-on technical skills, projects, and overall personal grooming.

LIBRARY WORKSHOP

Library Department and IQAC of Deccan Education Society's Navinchandra Mehta Institute of Technology and Development in association with DES's J. S. Kothari Business School, Library Department, Mumbai; had organized One Day National Level Online Workshop on ""Making Your Library Truly Ubiquitous: Illustrated with Real - World Library Cases"". The fee for attending the workshop was Rs. 250. Thirty-five paid participants and twelve in-house participants had applied for this webinar. More than 50 participants attended the workshop.

Background of the workshop: The COVID- 19 pandemic has taught us many life lessons. In academics, the major challenge was the transition and change from physical to online delivery of information services. We as library professionals, during the pandemic period, were finding ways to reach our students to help them to provide information through various ways and sources. One of the terms which were highly discussed and deliberated in library and information Science field was 'Ubiquitous Library Services'. Concept, Architecture, and Features According to the Oxford English Dictionary (O.E.D. 2nd Ed.), the ubiquity is described as "the capacity of being everywhere or in all places at the same time." The basic concept of the ubiquitous library is the library accessible from anywhere at any time. With the emergence of the Internet and the World Wide Web, the dream of the ubiquitous library has already become a reality. Understanding various successful real-world examples of ubiquitous library cases will help in understanding the innovative services we can offer our customers. In today's webinar, we will be discussing various library services based on ubiquitous technology with the help of 3 real-world cases. Aim or Purpose of the workshop: The Workshop aims to orient the participants to understand the concept ubiquitous library and to know real-world various unique services based on remote access.

Learning Objectives:

1. The key objective of this workshop was to build awareness about the concept of ubiquitous libraries, its benefits to the researcher and the educational institution where the researcher is working.
2. To discuss the statistical tools like the h Index, I10 Index for measuring impact factors.

3. To learn the method of calculating the h Index and I10 Index.
4. Facilitating the exchange of experiences regarding best research practices for quality enhancement among the participants from various institutions.
Participants: Received 48 Google Application forms from all over India.

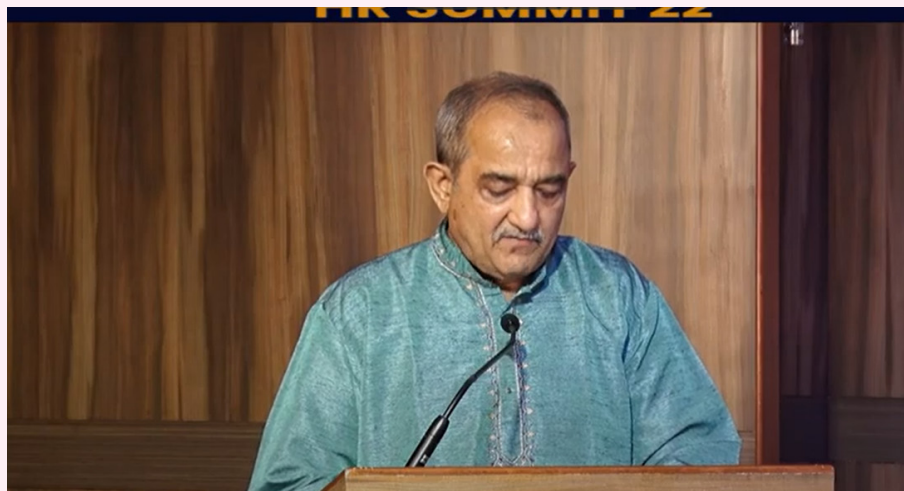

2. To learn to get acquainted with the database to increase the usage of the database.

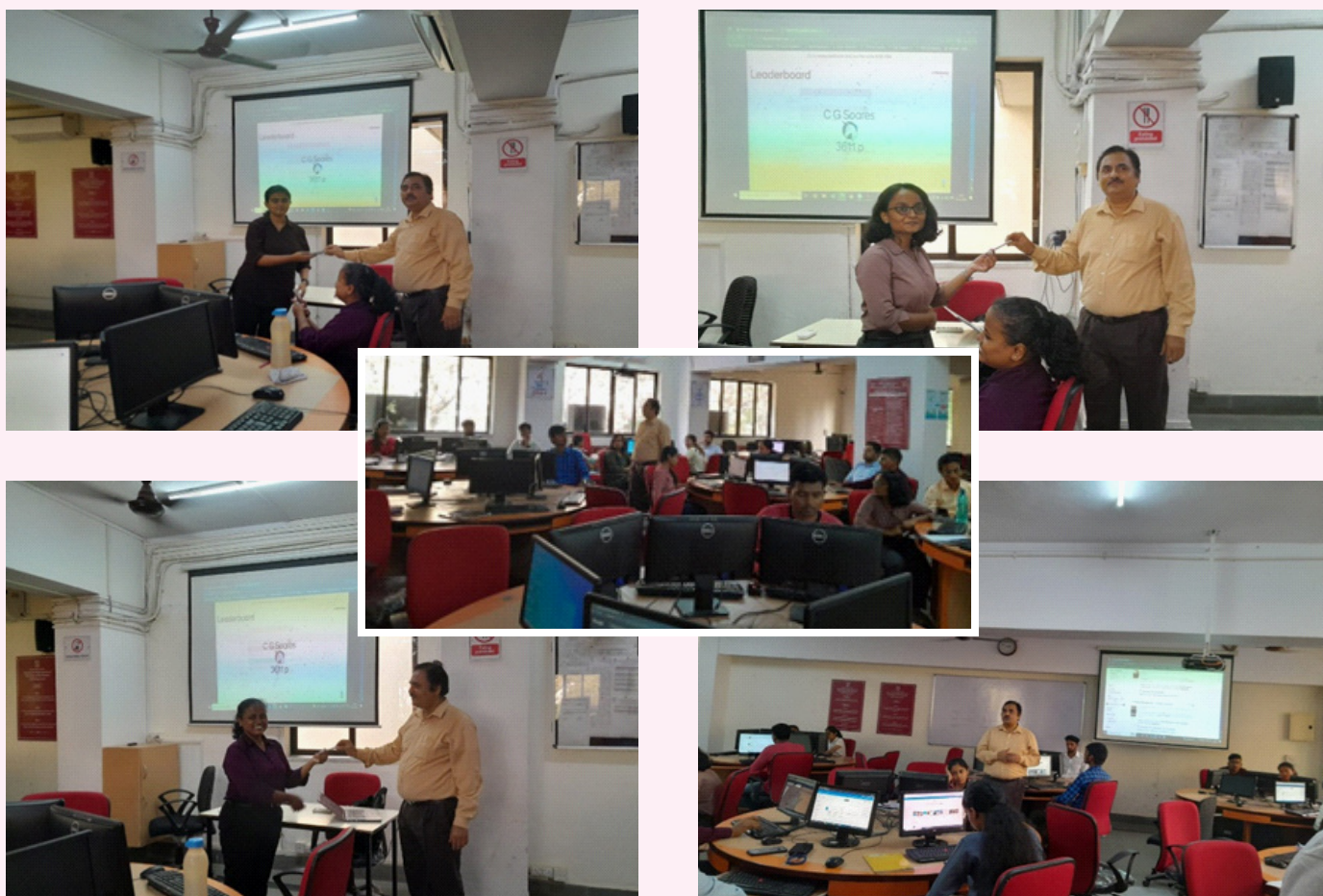
Scope:

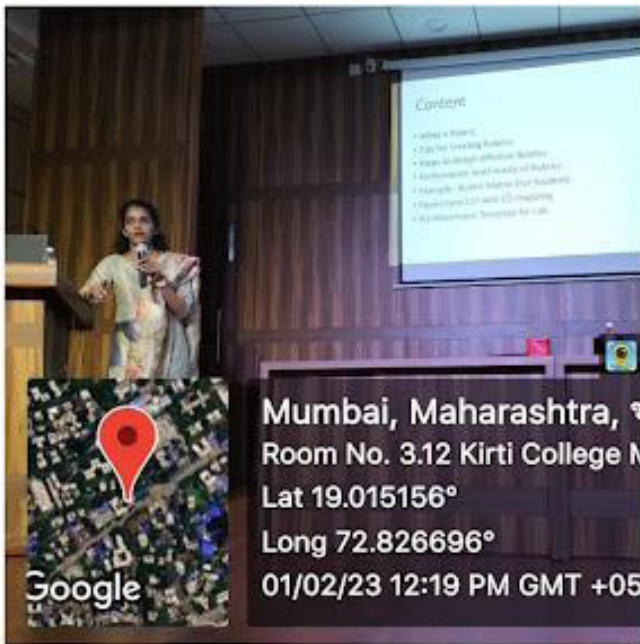
The session and mapping template was well appreciated by the attendees and organizers.

ज्ञानपीठ पुरस्कार विजेते मराठी कवी कुसुमाग्रज यांचे महाराष्ट्राच्या सांस्कृतिक क्षेत्रातील योगदान महत्त्वपूर्ण असल्याने त्यांना अभिवादन म्हणून २१ जानेवारी २०१३ रोजी महाराष्ट्र शासनाच्या निर्णयानुसार कुसुमाग्रजांचा जन्मदिवस २७ फेब्रुवारी हा 'मराठी भाषा गौरव दिन' म्हणून घोषित करण्यात आले. महाराष्ट्र राज्य सांस्कृतिक धोरण २०१०मध्ये कवी कुसुमाग्रज यांचा जन्मदिवस २७ फेब्रुवारी हा मराठी भाषा गौरव दिन म्हणून नमूद केलेले आहे. गजानन दिगंबर माडगूळकर(१ ऑक्टोबर १९१९- १४ डिसेंबर १९७७) हे विख्यात मराठी कवी, गीतकार, लेखक आणि अभिनेते होते. ते त्यांच्या नावाची आद्याक्षरे ग.दि.मा. या नावाने लोकप्रिय आहेत. गदिमांची सर्वात उल्लेखनीय रचना असलेल्या गीतरामायण ची बऱ्याच भाषांमध्ये भाषांतरे झाली आहेत. गीतरामायण या त्यांच्या सर्वात उल्लेखनीय कलाकृतीमुळे त्यांना सध्याच्या काळातील आधुनिक वाल्मिकी देखील म्हटले जाते. गदिमांनी त्यांच्या कारकिर्दीत १५७ पटकथा आणि २००० गाणी लिहिली. त्यांनी बऱ्याच मराठी व हिंदी चित्रपटांसाठी कथा, पटकथा आणि संवाद लिहिले आहेत. लिखाणासोबत त्यांनी काही

चित्रपटांमध्ये अभिनय देखील केला. भारत सरकारने १९६९ मध्ये गदिमांना पद्मश्री हा चौथा सर्वोच्च नागरी सन्मान देऊन त्यांचा गौरव केला. मराठी भाषा गौरव दिना प्रीत्यर्थ २७ फेब्रुवारी रोजी डी. इ. एस. च्या नवीनचंद्र मेहता इन्स्टिट्यूट ऑफ टेकनॉलॉजिच्या ग्रंथालयामध्ये 'मराठी भाषा गौरव दिना' प्रीत्यर्थ विविध विषयांच्या मराठी पुस्तकांचे प्रदर्शन आयोजित केले होते. या पुस्तक प्रदर्शनमध्ये खास करून आपण या वर्षी ग. दि. माडगूळकर यांच्या कविता संग्रहाचे आणि कथा संग्रहाचे विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी तसेच शिक्षक व शिक्षकेतर कर्मचाऱ्यांसाठी प्रदर्शन आयोजित करण्यात आले होते.

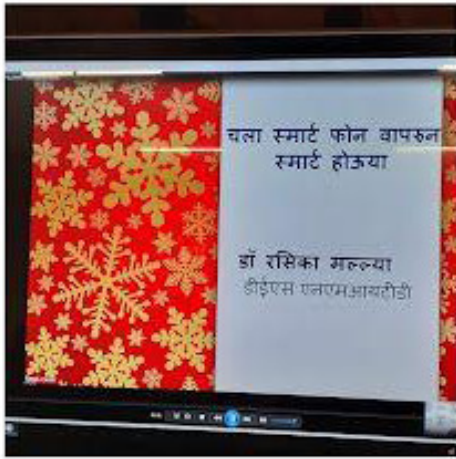

As part of their Social Relevance project MMS-IT Semester 4 students visited **Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram School** located at Talasari, Palghar District on 20th April. In all 13 MMS-IT students visited the ashram school, which included 7 students at Navinchandra Mehta Institute of Technology & Development (NMITD) and 6 students of Vidyalkar Institute of Technology (VIT). They were accompanied by two faculty members: Mr. Pratik Desai, and Mr. Ganesh Bhagwat, both assistant professors in the MCA department of NMITD.

The faculty members and students interacted with over sixty 9th grade students who were undergoing their summer preparatory classes for the next years' important SSC board exams.

Prof. Ganesh started the interaction with these bright-eyed young boys and girls in his characteristic friendly tone. He tried to open their minds to the possible educational avenues in IT/CS post their 10th standard. He put them completely at ease, making them feel safe to open and freely interact.

After him Prof. Pratik tried to explain to them, in a very simple jargon-free language, the basic working mechanism of a typical computer. He also touched upon the beautiful concept of algorithms and how they empower a computer as a bare machine to tackle a variety of different tasks.

Then MMS-IT students introduced the eager students to Google Assistant and how they can freely interact with it in their own usual mother tongue. They even did a live demonstration of Google Assistant for them.

At the end, the students and faculty distributed the goodies they brought for the Ashram School pupils. The schoolboys and girls all looked so very excited and happy by all this. The icing on the cake was the inspiring & insightful address of Shri Madhav Barve, the Chairman of the Talasari Ashram School project.

Mr. Barve addressed the students for a good more than half an hour, discussing with them the history, culture, worldview and lifestyle of the local tribal community around Talasari. Madhav Barve Sir explained how empowering this tribal community to live a life of dignity without uprooting them from their cultural roots motivated

all their work. Coming to the topic of IT, he talked at length about the growing importance of data security in this era of cloud-based services. Last but not the least, he inspired the students by telling them about his & his close friends' indigenous experiments in coming up with innovative data security solutions, for which they were ultimately granted with two international IT patents.

All in all, it was a day well spent, packed with meaning full activities and insightful interactions for the faculty members and especially for the MMS IT students of both NMITD and VIT.

As a part of the Social Relevance of Business, Semester IV students of MMS, of DES's NMITD along with Faculty Members and Non-Teaching staff, took a pledge to do Shraamdaan for Forest Conservation of a Tribal Adivasi Hamlet, called Khairmal Pada, in Jawahar, District Palghar on Wednesday, 17th May 2022.

This visit was organized under the aegis of “VAYAM”. Vayyam is a voluntary movement for inclusive development, environment, and democracy, and was started by Shri. Milind Thathe, who is a Thinker, writer, expert in community mobilization, and master's in resource governance

It was a strenuous journey from Dadar to Jawahar. Jawhar is known for its picturesque setting and vibrant cultural heritage.

Once we reached Jawahar, the students had to do trekking to go to the remote Pada called Khairmal which has a population of less than 56 people. The pada received electricity just 2 years back.

Students along with the Nisarg Mitra of Vayyam, dug more than 112 holes for tree plantation. It was very difficult to dig the holes in the hard ground.

The land under the forest conservation in this place is about 162 hectares and has many herbs, plants having medicinal values.

After that, they had simple but rustic meals prepared by the tribal community and listened with rapt attention to a talk by Shri. Vinayak Thalkar Dada, who stressed the need for Forest Conservation and the importance of rights of the Tribal Community.

Overall, a very enriching and soulful experience.

We take this opportunity to thank CDC Chairman, DES's NMITD Adv Helekar Sir for his advice and guidance for making this a great learning opportunity for the students.
