GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS:

- **Review Process**: All contributions submitted for publication will be subjected to peerreview. The Chief Editor reserves the right of making editorial amendments in the manuscript to meet the journal's standards.
- Format: Articles/Papers (3000-8000 words), and book reviews should be neatly typed as Word document with 1.5 spacing in Times New Roman, 12-point font size justified text. The author(s) must also submit the soft copy of article/paper through e-mail.
- The paper should be accompanied with an Abstract (150-300 words) and a list of keywords.
- **Footnotes** to the text should be avoided. If required, they should be numbered consecutively and presented as endnotes.
- **References** should be indicated in the text by giving the name of author(s), with the year of publication in parentheses. All references should be alphabetically listed at the end of the paper in the standard APA format.
- The authors should submit the copyright form in the given format.
- **Copyright** of all accepted papers for publication and use in any form/format will vest with D.E.S's NMITD.
