We started by learning about tools used to check networks for sniffing. The student demonstrated the use of tools like Wireshark used for sniffing purposes. We also saw how these tools can capture and study the information going through a network.

### 2. Steganography - Sending Secret Messages

#### a. In Pictures

Next, we got to know about hiding messages in pictures. The student demonstrated the use of command prompt to teach us how to put secret text in images without changing how they look.

#### b. In Audio

We also learned to hide messages in audio files. Using tools like Deep Sound and Audacity, we saw how to hide information within music or speech.

#### 3. Decoding Hidden Messages

Once the messages were hidden, the student showed us how to find them. We learned techniques to extract hidden information from pictures and audio. This included using special tools and understanding how to analyze hidden content.

#### Conclusion

The workshop gave us a practical understanding of cybersecurity and digital forensics. Exploring network tools and learning about hiding and finding hidden messages was interesting and useful.




