

ii. Grievance Redressal mechanism for Faculty, staff and students

NMITD is committed to provide a safe, fair and harmonious learning and working environment.

Grievance Redressal Cell facilitates the resolution of grievances in a fair and impartial manner involving the respective Department (dealing with the substantive function connected with the grievance), maintaining necessary confidentiality, as the case may be. Any stakeholder with a genuine grievance may approach Grievance Redressal Cell to submit his/her grievance in writing.

NMITD Dadar (W) Mumbai - 28. The function of the cell is to look into the complaints lodged by any student, and judge its merit.

Objective

The objective of the Grievance Cell is to develop a responsive and accountable attitude among all the stakeholders in order to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere in the institute.

Functions

- □ The cell formally will review all cases and will act accordingly as per the Management policy
- The cell will give report to the authority about the cases attended to and the number of pending cases, if any, which require direction and guidance from the higher authorities.

Procedure for lodging complaint

- The students may feel free to put up a grievance in writing and drop in the Grievance Box or handover to ant member of grievance cell
- The Grievance Cell will assure that the grievance has been properly solved in a stipulated time limit provided by the cell.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP)

- An aggrieved Student may register a complaint, in writing, with the Committee.
 - The Committee reviews the complaint and is bound to call the Complainant to present his/her case within 10 days of the receipt of the complaint.
 - The Committee deliberates on the complaint and an appropriate decision is taken within a month of the receipt of the grievance.
 - In case the complaint is found to be false or frivolous, the Committee may take the appropriate action against the Complainant.

FOLLOW UP & MONITORING

Grievance Redressal Cell shall coordinate, monitor and ensure redressal within the stipulated time. Depending up on the seriousness of grievance



the Grievance Redressal Cell will follow them up regularly till their final disposal by way of reminders.


